


ADENOIDECTOMY POST OPERATIVE INFORMATION



WHAT IS NORMAL TO EXPECT FOR A WEEK AFTER SURGERY:

- Nasal congestion
- Nasal discharge
- Offensive odor
- Sleep disruption/snoring secondary to nasal congestion

WHAT IS NOT NORMAL POST OPERATIVELY:

- Fever over 38 degrees
- Severe irritability
- Headaches
- Lethargy

If any of the above occur, please contact your surgeon or present to ED.

ACTIVITIES AFTER ADENOIDECTOMY:

- Avoid swimming for 2 weeks.
- Return to daycare/school 3 days after surgery OR when you feel your child is ready.
- Avoid strenuous exercise for 1 week.
- Children less than 2yo generally take a full week to recover. Older children often return to normal activities within 3 days.



If your child has had Inferior Turbinate Coblation in addition to Adenoidectomy, the following are normal to expect:

- Nasal congestion and discharge lasting 2 weeks.
- Blood stained nasal discharge and nose bleeds.
- Nasal saline sprays to be used for 2 weeks. (2 sprays each nostril 2-4 times per day)
- Nasal ointment may be prescribed
- Do not use nasal steroid spray for 4 weeks post operatively.
