

TONSILLECTOMY POST OPERATIVE INFORMATION

PANADOL

4 times in 24 hours for 5 to 8 days

NUROFEN

3 times in 24 hours for 5 to 8 days

OPIATES OXYCODONE

4-6 hourly as needed

OTHER MEASURES

Distraction, "icey poles" and "slurpies" are very soothing



- Don't take oxycodone and other strong pain relief ie codone (painstop) or tramadol
- Ensure patient has taken panadol and nurofen before considering oxycodone
- Opiates have side effects of drowsiness and nausea and vomiting: ensure you actively observe your child after taking oxycodone especially if they are asleep (oxycodone slows the breathing if too much given or the patient is sensitive if this occurs call an ambulance). I advise to avoid giving at night time if possible. This is not always possible.
- Bleeding from the mouth is not normal (coughing, spitting or vomitting blood). If there is more than a tablespoon of blood from the mouth, urgently take your child the to emergency department.

Pain and suffering varies significantly between children. It is normal to have a sore throat, offensive breath, nasal discharge, and referred pain to the ears. Often the ear pain is the most bothersome symptom

REGULAR PAIN RELIEF IS REQUIRED

Alternate panadol and nurofen to ensure at least one of the medications is working at all times. In addition to panadol and nurofen, opiate pain relief (oxycodone) can be administered at the same time. Icepoles and distraction have a significant benefit.

PARTIAL TONSILLECTOMY

Patients will require regular panadol for atleast 5 days. Nurofen can be used in addition to panadol on an as needed basis.

TOTAL TONSILLECTOMY

Patients will require regular panadol for atleast 7 days. Nurofen is likely to be needed regularly as well for 7 days. On days 5-8, the pain will escalate and Oxycodone may be required on an as needed basis.
