

Anoka County Growers' Association

Rules and Regulations

1. The yearly membership fee per Association member is \$50.00. Membership fees and your Certificate of Insurance are due to the association's treasurer by April 1st of each year, potential vendor application is due within two (2) weeks of receiving it.
2. Any Association member wishing to remain in the Association, but not sell produce; will be required to pay the yearly membership fee.
3. All stall fee pre-paid. Stall fees are \$120.00 for Saturday only and \$60 for each additional market, which must be paid to the treasurer at least two weeks before market opens. Seasonal (such as apples) sellers may estimate how many times they will be at the market and pay \$10 for each time.
4. The stall size shall be (15) feet at all markets, and Association members shall pay for all stalls used.
5. Any person wishing to join the Association must apply by filing out an application form. New vendors accepted will be on a two-year probational period.
6. Applicants seeking membership in the Association must either own the land upon which his or her produce is grown, or live upon land rented by the applicant upon which his or her produce is grown.
7. New applicants must qualify under the Association's by-laws and pay an annual membership fee of \$50.00. The Association Executive Board shall determine whether to accept or reject an applicant for membership and notify them of the decision within thirty (30) days of receiving the individual's application.
8. The Association shall have elections at the annual meeting, which is held in late October or early November of each year. There are three officers; President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer. They will be known as the 'Executive Board'. They will have a three-year term with only one elected at a time. All terms begin December 31 of the year elected.
