F1	Displays the Microsoft Office Excel Help.	
F2	Edits the active cell.	
F3	Pastes a name from the Paste Name dialog box (provided that names have been defined in the workbook.)	
F4	Repeats the last command or action, if possible.	
F5	Displays the Go To dialog box.	
F6	Moves to the next pane.	
F7	Displays the Spelling dialog box	
F8	Turns extend mode on or off.	
F9	Calculates all worksheets in all open workbooks.

Key Command	Description	ERJ Consulting
COMMAND+/	Displays the Microsoft Office Excel Help.	
COMMAND+SHIFT+S	Displays the Save As dialog box.	
COMMAND+Y	Repeats the last command or action, if possible.	
CONTROL+U	Edits the active cell.	
F5	Displays the Go To dialog box.	
Fn+F10	Turns key tips on or off.	
Fn+F11	Creates a pivot chart in the new worksheet.	
Fn+F6	Moves to the next pane.	
Fn+F7	Displays the Spelling dialog box

Fn+F9

Turns extend mode on or off.

Calculates all worksheets in all open workbooks.
