Key Command Description ALT+= Autosums selected cells ALT+F11 Displays VBA Editor Create, run, edit or delete a macro ALT+F8 Displays Delete dialogue box for removing rows CTRL+and cells Copies formula from the cell above into the CTRL+'(APOSTROPHE) active cell or the Formula Bar. Uses the Fill Down command to copy the CTRL+D contents and format of the topmost cell of a Displays Insert dialogue box for adding rows CTRL+SHIFT+= and cells Inserts the argument names and parentheses CTRL+SHIFT+A when the insertion point is to the right of a Used to enter array forumulas CTRL+SHIFT+ENTER Opens the Format Cells dialog box with the CTRL+SHIFT+F Font tab selected. Selects all cells that contain comments. CTRL+SHIFT+O Switches between expanding and collapsing of CTRL+SHIFT+U the formula bar. Calculates all open worksheets F9 SHIFT+F2 Inserts or edits a cell comment. Enables you to add a nonadjacent cell or range

to a selection of cells by using the arrow keys.

COMMAND+D	Uses the Fill Down command to copy the contents and format of the topmost cell of a	
COMMAND+SHIFT+T	Autosums selected cells	
CTRL+-	Displays Delete dialogue box for removing rows and cells	
CTRL+'(APOSTROPHE)	Copies formula from the cell above into the active cell or the Formula Bar.	
CTRL+SHIFT+=	Displays Insert dialogue box for adding rows and cells	
CTRL+SHIFT+A	Inserts the argument names and parentheses when the insertion point is to the right of a	
CTRL+SHIFT+F	Opens the Format Cells dialog box with the Font tab selected.	
CTRL+SHIFT+RETURN	Used to enter array forumulas	
CTRL+SHIFT+U	Switches between expanding and collapsing of the formula bar.	
Fn+CTRL+SHIFT+O	Selects all cells that contain comments.	
Fn+F9	Calculates all open worksheets	
Fn+Option+F11	Displays VBA Editor	
Fn+Option+F8	Create, run, edit or delete a macro	
Fn+SHIFT+F8	Enables you to add a nonadjacent cell or range to a selection of cells by using the arrow keys.	
Fn+SHIFT+F9	Calculates the active worksheet	
SHIFT+F2	Inserts or edits a cell comment.
