We have you in our heart!

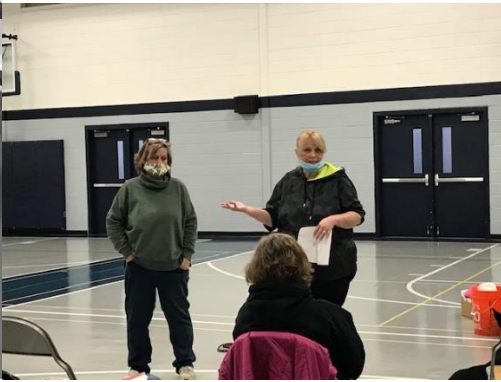
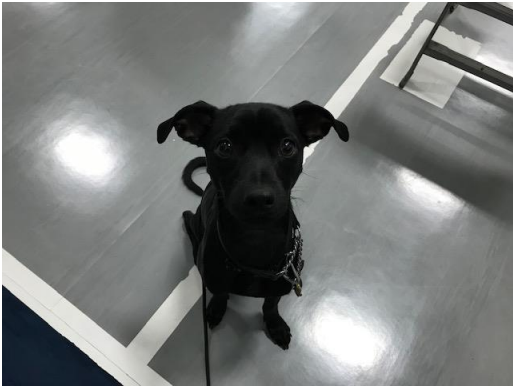
