Holistic Hounds



We are shedding coats (and giving the birds some nesting materials)!

- Omega-3 fatty acids are a great additive to your dog's food! Improves their coat's shine, shed control, and workability (helps while checking for ticks).
- Think about applying a natural flea and tick repellent. Consider geranium oil or Turmeric oil as an alternate to pesticides.
- Reduce ticks in the yard <u>with tick</u> <u>tubes</u> made with recycled toilet paper rolls, permethrin, and dryer lint.

#### Hound's Tooth

**PUPcicles!** 

Prep time – 5-15 mins Quantity – 12+

#### Ingredients/Materials:

- Ice cube tray
- Your dogs favorite treat (watermelon, banana, apple bits, canned pumpkin, pure peanut butter, etc.)
- A few baby carrots
- 1. Insert your dogs favorite treat
- 2. Mix in some peanut butter or pumpkin (be sure to check that there is no xylitol or birch sugar in your ingredients)
- 3. Add a baby carrot hanging off the side to act as a "pupcicle stick"
- 4. Freeze for 3-ish hours until hardened
- 5. You can add to a bowl of water to cool off your water bowl on a hot day or give to your dog "mostly" frozen
