School Leaver Employment Support (SLES) is an early intervention approach for NDIS participants of school leaving age to guide and support through the options available after school.

Finding and Keeping a Job (FAKAJ) is a plan specific funding item given to eligible NDIS participants who are interested in entering the workforce. It's not Disability Employment Services (DES).

- ✓ *Disability Operation Network support (DON's) will provide you with career mentoring, counselling and capacity building services.*
- ✓ *It will be HOLISTIC and Person Centred Approach driven.*
- ✓ *This is your journey ... We would like to see you build your job skills, confidence and independence.*
- ✓ *We will work with you, your formal and informal supports to action a transition plan from school to employment.*
- ✓ *We will connect you with strong network of employers and community partners*
