"for all the nations have drunk the wine of her impure passion, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her" (18:3)	"Babylon was a golden cup in the LORD's hand, making all the earth drunken; the nations drank of her wine, therefore the nations went mad" (Jer. 51:7)
"Come out of her, my people, lest you take part in her sins, lest you share in her plagues" (18:4)	"Flee from the midst of Babylon, let every man save his life! Be not cut off in her punishment" (Jer. 51:6)
"For her sins are heaped high as heaven" (18:5)	"for her judgment has reached up to heaven, and has been lifted up even to the skies" (Jer. 51:9)

"Render to her as she herself has rendered" (18:6)	"Requite her according to her deeds, do to her according to all that she has done" (Jer. 50:29; cf. 51:6)
"she shall be burned with fire" (18:8)	"her dwellings are on fire" (Jer. 51:30)
"Rejoice over her, O heaven, O saints and apostles and prophets, for God has given judgment for you against her" (18:20)	"Then the heavens and the earth and all that is within them, shall sing for joy over Babylon; for the destroyers shall come against them out of the north" (Jer. 51:48)
"And in her was found the blood of prophets and of saints, and of all who have been slain on earth" (18:24)	"Babylon must fall for the slain of Israel, as for Babylon have fallen the slain of the earth" (51:49)
