How To Maintain your Wig

Wash your wig every 15 wears or as necessary if it is oily or has a odor and treat it as a delicate garment.

Step 1 Prepare your Wig	Gently brush your hair system with a wide-tooth comb or brush, starting at the ends and working your way up to the roots before getting your hair wet.
Step 2 Wash the Wig	Human Hair: Gently mix 1 to 2 capfuls of Brandywine Shampoo in warm water until it becomes sudsy. Synthetic Hair: Gently mix 1 to 2 capfuls of Brandywine Shampoo in cool water until it becomes sudsy.
Step 3 Swish the Wig	To prevent matting, avoid dropping the wig into the water or rubbing/twisting the hair. Instead, hold the wig gently and swish it back and forth in the water to keep the hair from tangling or knotting.
Step 4 Rinse Wig	Use cool water for synthetic hair or warm water for human hair. Hold the wig and swish the hair repeatedly until the product is completely rinsed out. Blot the hair dry with a towel, but do not rub, brush, or comb it.
Step 5 Condition Wig	Fill sink / container approx. 3" with fresh water and add wig conditioner. Add additional water to cover the wig. For long hair add conditioner to ends of hair, work in by hand. Condition up to one hour.
Step 6 Rinse Wig	Rinse Synthetic wig with cool water, Human Hair with warm water. Then blot dry with hand towel. Do not wring or twist hair.
Step 7 Dry Wig	Place wig on Wig Stand to dry overnight. Should dry within 24 hours.
Step 8 Style Wig	Hold wig from wig label in the back of the wig. Gently Brush with Wig Brush or Wide Tooth Comb from end of wig working up towards cap.
Puttin on Wig	Application: Hold wig from front with thumbs underneath placing front of wig on forehead above eyebrows working towards the back of your head. Adjust tabs on left and right to straighten wig, then adjust front of wig to proper forehead area that feels comfortable. Lace Front Wig: Do not pull on lace front wig area up to bonded seam. Adjust wig from crown area and back of wig.
Securing Wig	Wig Grip: Put wig grip on like a headband with label inside and on left. Apply band over your ears, then pop them out to insure the grip is low enough behind the ears. Fasten Velcro in back
