The time period spent in each stage will vary drastically from person to person based on their prior experience and demonstration of progress throughout our program.

Position Summary: To recruit, train, and manage volunteers to assist in the needs of the

organization.

Essential Duties:

- Assist in administrative duties, such as returning telephone calls, email and mail inquiries regarding volunteering for Stray Haven, review all incoming applications, and maintain a current volunteer contact list.
- Plan, promote, and lead on-site new volunteer orientations twice a month.

 Coordinate and lead small group training sessions as needed for volunteers.
- Ensure the volunteers and fosters are aware of expectations and provided training to complete their tasks
- Ensure proper recording and reporting of volunteer hours.
- Maintain an up-to-date volunteer handbook and FAQs.
- Coordinate with the Supervisors and/or Executive Director regarding needed volunteer areas/shifts, upcoming events, and new volunteer start dates.
- Provide planning, training, and management of volunteers.
- Assist in keeping appropriate SOPs up-to-date and readily available for volunteers.
- Operate as a point of contact for volunteers' issues/questions.
- Maintain, engage, and demonstrate appreciation for volunteers; i.e. Annual Volunteer Appreciation Party.
- Manage the volunteer recruitment and schedule to fill all shifts and other needs.
- Work to develop good rapport between volunteers and staff; keeping all interactions positive and respectful with staff demonstrating appreciation for our volunteers.
- Proactively build relationships within the community to recruit volunteers businesses, retirement centers, youth and veteran associations, etc.

Volunteer Title: Cat Foster **Volunteer Level:** Tier 2

Dual Direct Reports to: Cat Care Supervisor and Volunteer Coordinator

Position Summary:

Responsible for the daily care of a foster animal, including feeding, exercising, playtime, socialization, grooming, reinforcing basic obedience commands and, of course, providing patience, love and security. Stray Haven will provide all necessary medical care and our Foster Teams will provide full support throughout the foster period. Any additional expenses incurred by the foster parent may be tax-deductible. Must be willing to work with the pet to help them get ready for adoption. This may include housebreaking, basic training, socialization, etc. You may also need to transport the foster animal to scheduled medical appointments and/or adoption events and photoshoots as well as administer any required medications. Providing foster care will certainly be a rewarding experience as you are enabling the animal to go on to the greatest adventure – a place where he/she will be cherished and loved until a great forever home is found.

- Fold laundry
- Sweep

 Write cat bios and assist in other cat care administrative duties at cat care supervisor's discretion



Socialization)

Volunteer Level: Tier 1

Dual Direct Reports to: Dog Care Supervisor and Dog Care Facilitator

Position Summary:

To provide light assistance to dog care staff while primarily working to enrich, exercise, and socialize our dogs.

Essential Duties:

- Wash dishes
- Change laundry
- Fold laundry
- Water
- Clean dog yard
- Fill kongs
- Walk level 1 dogs with staff supervision
- Free play in yards with level 1 dogs with staff supervision
- Basic training of level 1 dogs with staff supervision

Volunteer Title: Dog Care Volunteer (Enclosure Cleaning & Grooming)

**Volunteers under 14 are NOT allowed to have direct contact with the animals. They may, however, read to the animals or play card games outside of the enclosures to allow the animals to become acclimated to the presence of people.

To provide assistance to our staff and socialization for our companion animals. This position is 50% assisting staff and 50% cat socializing.

- Wash Dishes
- Sweep Floors
- Dust Lobby
- Socialize Cats at the Cat Care Supervisor's Discretions

Volunteer Title: Group **Volunteer Level:** Tier 1

Dual Direct Reports to: Office Supervisor and Volunteer Coordinator

Position Summary:

To provide large scale assistance to our staff.

Three options:

- 1. Deep Cleaning Day The group's volunteer date would be coordinated with a staff's deep cleaning project. For example, this might be a day where we deep clean and sanitize a storage room, an office, an outdoor area, etc.
- 2. Project/Event Day The group's volunteer date would be coordinated with an event or large scale project. For example, this might include repairing and shampooing all the cat trees or decorating for an adoption event.
- 3. Separate, but together The group's volunteers would disperse among the departments and complete a variety of tasks including, but not limited to filing, scooping the yards, washing dishes, sweeping, power washing, and laundry.


