Your cat was spayed today. Please follow these Post-Op instructions:

- 1. Keep the cat inside, warm and dry tonight. She can have water and half the normal amount of food tonight. Tomorrow, you can feed her according to her regular schedule. (If your cat is a kitten, she should be fed the normal amount tonight, at her regular feeding times).
- 2. Restrict your cat's activity for 10 to 14 days after surgery. Discourage running, jumping, rough play.
- 3. Monitor the incision for signs of heat, pain, redness discharge, or odor. Call the number below if any of these signs occur. Please do not let the cat lick her incision.
- 4. There are no sutures (stitches) to remove.
- 5. As per National high quality, high volume, spay neuter guidelines, your animal has been tattooed, which indicates that this animal has been sterilized. You will see a green line on your pet's abdomen. The color green is normal (that is the tattoo ink). Please call if you this tattoo area looks red or has any discharge around the tattoo site.
