Manufacturer Recommended VENEER STONE INSTALLATION



To ensure proper adhesion, wash the back of the stone to make sure it is free & clear of dirt or residue. Darker colored stones may exhibit signs of efflorescence. This is normal in cementitious material and can easily be removed using an efflorescence remover or normal acid wash after the stone is installed. SAFETY INFO

Sanding, grinding, or cutting concrete can release large amounts of dust containing high levels of crystalline silica. Prolonged or repeated exposure can lead to a disabling & often fatal lung disease called silicosis. Avoid contact with dust when cutting our stone and do not breath in dust. Wear proper protective clothing, gloves & eye protection.
