## STRIPS

## The following is an example for cutting 2 INCH STRIPS:

Place the glass on the ruler. (figure 1) If we slide the glass right or left to the number $\mathbf{2}$ and make a score, we will have a 2 INCH strip.

> You may continue making consecutive scores by sliding the glass along the ruler to the next desired width.

HINT: It is much easier to look at the corner edge of the glass than to look at a score-line. Sometimes the score-line may not be visible.

## SQUARES

## The following is an example for cutting 2 INCH SQUARES:

 After you cut your 2 INCH strip, you can cut it into 2 INCH squares.Place the glass on the ruler.
If we slide the glass to the right (figure 2) or left to the number 2 and make a score, we will have a 2 INCH SQUARE.

HINT: You may continue making consecutive squares by sliding the glass along the ruler to the next desired width.
