ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

For all Products

- Tincture + \$110 x 3 or 4/mo = \$440
- Distillates + \$70/disty x 3 = \$210
- Vape Pax Pens + \$65 x 2 = \$130
- Edibles + \$103 x 3 = \$309

TOTAL INCREASE: \$1,089

For this example, it would cost
~\$400 monthly
if living in a Patient-protected State
