

- Scrapghans: Spring means cleaning up and making space. Let's put those leftovers and scraps to good use in big colorful projects. Afghans are great outlets for creative freedom, allowing you to put colors and bits of yarn together to make beautiful works of art.
- Spring Capsule Wardrobe: Start the new year with simple basics you can wear all year long. In a capsule wardrobe, the focus is on easy-to-wear garments and pieces in classic styles. The garments are stylish and can be layered and worn with a number of outfits. Basic tees, shells, cardigans, vests and sweaters are key pieces for this type of wardrobe.
