- Oh Baby!: Wrap that little one in love with projects designed especially with babies in mind—small, soft blankets, cocoons, little hats and booties, keepsake pieces, tiny sweaters or baby-safe toys. Baby showers are also a constant in many lives, and projects that would make great gifts are part of this section.

- Amigurumi for Beginners: Amigurumi creations have become quite popular as collectibles and gifts. Simple starter projects will help new stitchers create cute yet simple animals or dolls to display on a bookshelf, key chain or desktop.
- Market Bags: Many places are doing away with paper and plastic bags. For this chapter, we'll feature beautiful and stylish bags of all sorts: large shopping bags to keep in the vehicle, small pouches that fit in your purse but easily unfold, sturdy totes with wide bottoms and other designs.
