**Manager Report:** Beth Yousey presented the manager's reports. The manager's report is included in the Board of Director's package entered as part of the Association records.

A proposal from Maddie and Daddie was presented to the Board of Directors for repair of sidewalk behind the Town Homes.

A motion was made by Shantel Ocampo to approve the Maddie and Daddie proposal of \$5,900.00 and not to exceed \$6,000.00 and seconded by Bryan Lalone and unanimously passed.

Two proposals Hall Company and Asphalt Restoration Technology Systems were presented and review by the Board to reseal pavement in phase 1 of the roads. A third proposal, Rose Paving was removed from consideration.

A motion was made by Scott Harwood to approve the proposal by Asphalt Restoration Technologies Systems for \$ 79,590, which will include the application of pavement dressing conditioner and restriping in all areas except for area in front of the club house, which will only include asphalt sealcoating and restriping and seconded by Ralph Bergeron and unanimously passed.
