Preview of poetry workshop:

6/19

Post-session activity: Finding a poem(s) that inspires you, annotate it; brainstorm your own ideas

Dive into contemporary work and free form; reinforce understanding of literary devices

Post-session activity: Write your poem, rough draft

6/22

Workshop in small groups; provide and receive feedback

Post-session activity: make final edits based on discussion
