This month's featured speaker is Captain Daniel Andrews, Co-Founder and Executive Director of Captains for Clean Water. Captain Daniel will cover topics including: the current state of Everglades restoration projects, how water management decisions impact our fisheries and local economy, and ways the fishing community can get engaged in protecting our waters. A Professional fishing guide for more than five years, Daniel and the co-founder of the organization, Captain Chris Wittman, literally "walked away from their dream jobs to try to save those dream jobs."

Captain Andrews will also discuss the controversial proposed phosphate mine called the Southland Water Resource Project planned directly adjacent to the Everglades Agricultural Area (EAA) Reservoir, a centerpiece of Everglades restoration. This mine could have significant impacts on our water quality and poses a significant risk to further degrade our already stressed water quality.
