Speakers: Dr. Ryan Orgera, SCCF CEO and Rae Ann Wessel, SCCF Director of Natural Resource Policy

Topic: Water Quality Update

This month's featured speakers are Ryan Orgera, Ph.D. and Rae Ann Wessel, Natural Resource Policy Director at the Sanibel and Captiva Conservation Foundation (SCCF). Dr. Orgera was recently appointed as the new CEO of SCCF and he, along with Rae Ann, will be discussing the current status of the progress being made toward the restoration of the Everglades and the long term solutions to the water quality issues that have negatively impacted Southwest Florida for the past several years.

Prior to taking over the reins at SCCF in January of this year, Ryan worked on the Ending Illegal Fishing Project as well as the Global Shark Conservation team with the Pew Charitable Trusts. Working across the globe, from Africa to South America, Ryan helped ensure global protections for thirteen species of sharks and rays. He is currently a member of the Federal Marine Protected Area Advisory Committee and remains deeply committed to conservation efforts both locally and internationally. Rae Ann Wessel will be on hand to discuss in detail her work on improving our local water quality, work which directly affects the fisheries and fishing in our back bays and estuaries.
