For our first Outing I have planned an inshore 'Dartboard' format that has a nice wide variety of target fish species: snook, redfish, black drum, snapper, sheepshead, pompano, ladyfish, mackerel, jacks, grouper and trout. This should also provide for a good conversation at the November meeting when we can share what bait, or plastics, etc., were working and where the hotspots were. Equally important is to take a note of the water health, clarity, baitfish abundance, and seagrass locations to share.
