
#### **Congregational Care Coordinator**

#### **New AED at FCC**

Last month, First Christian received a new AED machine from Graham Hospital's Foundation. This machine that can be a lifesaver in case of a heart attack, is going to be installed on the first floor of the church, near the fellowship hall. First Christian already has another AED machine, on the top floor, by the bell tower, directly outside of the sanctuary area. But in his grant request to the Foundation, Pastor Steve noted the need for another machine much closer to the side of the church that gets used on a more frequent basis and how those seconds of not having to find it upstairs could help save lives.

This month we are finalizing a fund through the Christian Church Foundation set up specifically for this cause. And, as it stands, with only \$2000 more in gifts, we can double the initial impact of the fund and show our support for the Meades and the literacy of our town's children. Starting in March of 2025 Phase 3 of the Living Legacy Plan will begin. The first event will


be a celebration dinner for all who are Living Legacy Partners at that time. Quarterly efforts will follow through the year. Please pray that God continues to bless this giving ministry.
