For those of us who are novice gardeners, it is a rude awakening that first season when you discover the gardening involves more than planting a seed and simply waiting for that flower, vegetable or fruit to show up. You all know it takes weeding, pruning and watering, at the least. That's because for the plant to develop and bear fruit, it must grow deeper roots and mature.



There is a reason why Jesus and so many authors of our scriptures describe faith in terms of gardens and plants. We have to grow and mature – we need passionate spirituality to become the kind of deeper disciples who bear good fruit. At First Christian Church, we are committed to that vision of fostering such disciples. After all, imagine if your faith lacked the kind of basic care we give to a vegetable garden. If the only sermons you ever heard were children's sermons, if Bible study never addressed the deep and challenging complexities of life, if you always relied on other adults to say your prayers or if you never learned how to share the gospel with those around you. That kind of faith would never carry you through hardships, it wouldn't help you dig deeper roots, blossom and fruit into the kind of dedicated disciples that Jesus calls you to be.

So here is the ask: we need some people who will commit to imagining what will make our faithful garden grow. In other words, we need some people who will commit to meeting together a few times, to help us decide what programs in ministries can help us grow as deeper disciples. We need people who are passionate about Bible study or prayer or being a welcoming and inviting church. And we need people who may never have been satisfied with ways you have experienced those things in the past, but who have hope and ideas for the future.

I trust that within this congregation, there are hearts and minds who want to grow deeper, who feel that our faith offers a bumper crop of support in life and that we want to share it with our neighbors. I bet we have people who will commit to being on a team that cultivates this church's discipleship. People who can plan studies and small groups, people who have ideas on how we can help welcome new people beyond our current congregation and how to mature the faiths of people in our midst.

If you think you might be one of these people who will help imagine how we can tend to our garden of discipleship, please reach out to me and let me know within the next week or two so that we can assemble a team to dream and take the first steps in caring for First Christian's garden of faith. --Pastor Steve
