This month, instead of a long reflection on activities or programs going on, I thought I would share a poem that speaks to someplace deep in my feelings about Advent and Christmas. It's called "Welcome Morning" by Anne Sexton:

There is joy in all: in the hair I brush each morning, in the Cannon towel, newly washed, that I rub my body with each morning, in the chapel of eggs I cook each morning, in the outcry from the kettle that heats my coffee each morning, in the spoon and the chair that cry "hello there, Anne" each morning, in the godhead of the table that I set my silver, plate, cup upon each morning.

All this is God, right here in my pea-green house each morning and I mean, though often forget, to give thanks, to faint down by the kitchen table in a prayer of rejoicing as the holy birds at the kitchen window peck into their marriage of seeds.

So while I think of it, let me paint a thank-you on my palm for this God, this laughter of the morning, lest it go unspoken.

The Joy that isn't shared, I've heard, dies young.

There is much that could be said about the meanings of Advent and Christmas, the many ways we try and touch the source of the amazingly good news that God is with us, in a way that we can understand and touch and feel.

But sometimes it's just waking up to see that holiness all around us in ordinary places... and that often requires us to slow down to see it.

Finally, notice the wisdom Sexton shares in reminding us that once we've discovered the Divine beauty all around us, like a Holy Spirit flame that needs air to breathe, that beauty and joy can only thrive when we share it!

So, this Advent and Christmas, I pray that you will slow down to see the joy, the beauty and the holiness that is all around us; and I pray that you'll find ways to nurture those gifts and share them with the ones God has put in your life!

May you savor this season, may you see God showing up every day and may you pass it on!
