You've Been Missed

Dear First Christian Church of Canton,

I just got back from my first camping experience at our Disciples of Christ camp, Camp Walter Scott (CWS—down near Dietrich, IL), and I need to tell you church: you've been missed. Gavin, Andie and Grant Stephenson, Isaac, Finn and myself were down for the "You and Me" camp (specially designed for kids exiting K-5th grade





and their family members) this past month and we literally received an ovation when we named what church we are from. An ovation. We weren't doing clapping for everyone; they just spontaneously burst out when we introduced ourselves. So many people came up and said something to the extent of, "Canton used to be a huge portion of our camp. But you haven't sent anyone in so long. We missed you." To give you a sense of how long it's been since we sent many folks, the director of that week's camp asked me how "little Kara Kemper" was doing these days!! So hear this loud and clear, Canton FCC,

the folks at CWS—as well as I'm sure other parts of our regional and general church ministry—not only have noted our recent absence, but they are longing for restored partnership and community.

And I'll say in our short, three-day camp with our kids, I had a blast. It had been 4 years for me since my last in-person church camp—and I haven't been away from church camp that long since I was younger than Finn is now. But from the moment I got out of the van



and long after I returned back to the daily grind, I could feel the restoration that I've never found anywhere quite as well as at church camp. During the three days with kids as young as 6 and guardians as old as 86, we experienced fun, fellowship, prayer and play in the healing natural setting of camp. Whether it was on the lake paddle boarding, fishing, paddle boating, playing card games, taking morning hikes to identify animals and plants, doing



crafts, singing silly songs, making homemade ice cream, hanging out with the goats, having smores, sitting around the firepit or even the always-loved FOB (feet on bunk) time after lunch in our air-conditioned cabins—it was just good to see my kids make new friends, watch them grow in compassion and curiosity, make new friends myself and return to the love of the Holy all around.



Our congregation has already committed to providing 48 backpacks, but if you'd like to personally donate some supplies for a (or


some) backpacks, you are invited to take a tag (kind of like our angel tree ministry) and get the supplies on the list and return them back to church by July 17th.
