Most people would respond, "fine." But as Rhonda Morgan reminded me, fine isn't even a feeling. As Rhonda said, fine really stands for Feelings I'm Not Expressing. We feel so much more than we let on. But many of us don't always have the vocabulary to express how we feel. Turns out that has real consequences. Renowned researcher, Brene Brown, in her book, Atlas of the Heart, writes that when we're limited in our language, research shows that we not only can't communicate emotion, it shapes how we feel—primarily, disconnected. Her book goes on to name and locate 87 different emotions, which is a help because her research of 7000 participants who were asked to name their emotions as they experienced them, on average could only name 3! Happy, sad and angry. They couldn't name when they feel disappointment, loneliness, awe, boredom, stress, anxiety, love and a whole host of other feelings. That can't be good.

Part of the Christian faith is to help us live fully. And if we aren't feeling, we aren't living. So, church, when did we stop feeling? Because the Bible is littered with stories of emotions—it is after all, the chronical of peoples' search for the holy in their lives. It's bound to have some tear-jerker moments, not to mention a fair deal of jump-for-joy times. God created you will a lot more than three emotions, which is why I hope you'll join us between now and the end of July; we'll be on an emotional rollercoaster of worship, called Good Feelings, helping teach us or at least remind us of our own feelings and to not only know about them, but remember that feeling is good! Having feelings is faithful! Give yourself permission to feel. In the coming weeks we'll talk about emotional intelligence: the capacity to recognize, understand, and manage our own emotions, as well as the emotions of others. We're going to explore six basic emotions: anger, sadness, fear, disgust, joy and thing we're calling genius. We're also going to have some fun, checking in with our emotions each week as a spiritual practice. We'll see clips from the family movie that could teach us all a thing or two about embracing our rich emotional capacity, Inside Out—we might even have a family movie night for that and even potentially going out together to see Inside Out 2 in the theater.

So as we explore Good Feelings, as you invite your friends to join in as well, I hope you can see how embracing our emotions allows us to connect more deeply with God and with one another.
