From the Re-Entry Committee:

With lowered transmission rates and lowered hospitalization rates recently for COVID-19 in our county, and with a continued high rate of vaccination among the FCC membership, the Re-entry Committee is implementing the following changes to go into effect immediately:

Face Masks: we will continue the practice of making masking optional for small groups. For worship, masks are not required, but are encouraged, especially during any singing.

Food: we will be allowing meals to be served at FCC. Please use care and consideration for safety and sanitary guidelines when preparing, serving and eating: minimizing time where people will be touching food and utensils of others, avoiding waiting in line without masks near food and encouraging distanced seating while eating.

Spacing in the sanctuary: at this point, there is no need to add seating capacity to the sanctuary, so we will continue our seating set up as is.

Lent at FCC: A Practical Faith

Each year around this time we observe Lent, a 40-day preparation for Easter. You may be familiar with Lent, but in most of our minds, Lent is a dour (maybe even boring?) season of fasting and enduring another Midwest winter; waiting for spring, Easter joy and Peeps.

But not this year. We'll still have joy (and Peeps!) but this year, we are *practicing* Lent, remembering that Jesus invites us to live more fully each day and that to really discover the depths of Easter joy, we need daily practices that help unveil that truth far beyond this season.

That's why we're calling this Lent, *A Practical Faith*. Each week, with wisdom from Barbara Brown Taylor's "Altar in the World" we'll explore a simple practice to help discover the wisdom and joy of

life that Jesus wants for each one of us. You'll have support for each practice with a weekly video called *Let's Practice!* (it will replace the "Minute at First" for Lent) and Wednesdays you can drop by for dinner, to practice together and we'll even talk a bit about our experiences.

This Lent, let's not just observe faith, let's *practice it*—in the ways we see, walk, live, love, work, rest, pray and bless—so that we might grow in the Spirit and continue becoming dedicated Disciples through our passionate spirituality!

They are an all volunteer staff and their funding comes only through donations. They accept all companion animals needing shelter, regardless of age, physical condition, or adopt-ability. We will also have a box for the donation of travel size shampoo and conditioner to donate to the Salvation Army.
