There's a lot of directions you could go—love, salvation, service, comfort, the list goes on and on. But if you asked me that question, I would say that God's underlying invitation that we learn through the Bible and we strive to live as church is to discover a life of freedom! I think those two words—life and freedom—because they are everywhere in our scripture. It's the thread that connects Genesis all the way to Revelation and everywhere in between. God's call to Abraham is to know and create life through generations of family. God literally frees the Israelites in Egypt, with the help of Moses, so that they may live free. The words of the prophets mainly boil down to, "don't put your energy into stuff or worldly powers, God wants to give you real life and real freedom, but you've got to let go of the other things." And Jesus continues and clarifies those messages, maybe nowhere more concisely than in John 10.10 when he says, "I came so that you might have life and have it abundantly."

No wonder the only prayer that Jesus explicitly teaches his disciples, that we repeat on a weekly basis together, essentially says, God you're great. We're gonna work with you to make earth act a bit more like heaven. That means that we need life (our daily bread), freedom (forgive us from the sin/trespasses/debts that tie us down) and God's guidance (lead us). So we're saying in the Lord's Prayer that in order for life, we need God's guidance to freedom. And we even name in the prayer, for those of us who pray, "forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors" that one of the most powerful forces that bind us up, that keep us away from God's invitation to a liberated life are economic forces. God knows that money and debt and greed are so often those things that misplace our priorities, that separate us from living free, which is why the Bible talks about money more than 2,500 times! More than 60% of Jesus' teachings were about economics!

To put our prayer into action, to help us accept God's invitation live a freed life, we're beginning a worship series Free to Live, Free to Give. Our worship series is going to help us re-prioritize our lives so that we can accept God's invitation to an abundant life of freedom. We'll be discussing how to reduce our debts, to name our financial goals, set (and keep) budgets and discover the joy of giving! Each of the 5 weeks will offer a lesson in good stewardship and a handout to guide you in living that lesson—it's not only spiritual wisdom, but Jesus wants us to put these ideas into practice. And throughout this series we need your stories of how God has freed you to live and give! We'll be inviting people to share stories for us to put together and share in worship. So be thinking about how God and the

church have freed you for living fully, freely and with generosity.

If you—or someone you know—has ever struggled with challenges of indebtedness, feeling anxious about money or being afraid of not having enough; come discover the freedom God offers to live and give, Sunday 9am worship in May and on June 2nd!


