All this month you're going to be hearing a lot about gratitude and giving thanks. That's great, but at FCC, we believe this spirit should guide us all year long; that's why inspiring generosity is a core part of our vision. That's why I'm so excited to share with you that your congregation is taking a major leap in putting our gratitude and spirit of generosity into action: we are creating the **Inspiring Generosity Grants** (or IGG)!

What is the IGG? It's our ministry to help support individuals or organizations in the Canton area to serve people with needs. Grants will be awarded to proposals that address a community need or support a new community service project in the Canton area

We're funding this ministry by taking a tithe of our Ingersoll Trust Fund (about \$9,500, annually) and sharing the blessing with our neighbors. Not only will our church be blessed by knowing that the IGG will help create more wholeness and goodness in Canton, but, as a church, we'll also be blessed by getting to hear back from the recipients since a part of the recipient's responsibility is to share their stories with the church. Ideally, there might even be some grants that FCC folk want to support through their volunteer efforts or even connect the granted program into a ministry of FCC.

In coming weeks you'll be hearing more in the larger community about the IGG, but we wanted to share the good news with you first! Currently the team working on IGG is composed of Don Heller, Laura Taylor, Daryle and Alan Coleman, Doreen Shaw and myself. The team has prayed, studied similar grants from around the country and we are working to finalize the application process. Once we've got our ducks in a row, we will make the grants and the application process public, later this month. We're planning on awarding our first grants this year!

So, let's see and pray how God will multiply the generosity of our hearts in this community through our Inspiring Generosity Grants! Talk about a reason to be thankful!


hope we share as much enthusiasm and creativity when it comes time to say thank you to all our volunteers.—Steve




