

But lately, I've heard quite a few questions that I want to address so that you not only know WHY you want to do this ministry but HOW it works.

- These are short term groups. Each week, two people will share their story. We're hoping groups will be 8-12 people, meaning the group will last 4-6 weeks. Find a group that fits your schedule so you can commit to being present for these sessions. The goal is that everyone gets to share and be done before Thanksgiving.
- Sometimes things have to happen organically. There may be a week where it feels
 a little quiet or the story isn't connecting. That's okay—this is more of a "feeling"
 than "doing" kind-of-ministry. As long as the group honors the storyteller's vulnerability and they can pray together, it is a success.
- The story: everyone has one and we're asking everyone, when it's your turn, to put it down in writing before the group. It should be no more than 1 page and if you need a prompt for your story, consider one of the following:
 - When was a time that you relied on your faith and how did it help you?
 - When did you know you wanted to follow Jesus and why?
 - What's a meaningful moment, relationship or experience in your life?

I'm excited to see what new stories and feelings will come out of these groups and to see how we can experience the Holy Spirit together. And, a big thanks in advance for our wonderful facilitators!
