# 4. Public Hearing: Condominium Plat Code Amendment. – action item

Chairperson, Emmy Masterson, introduced the topic and explained the order and procedure of the public hearing. Rand Wichman, city planner, gave a staff introduction of the proposed code amendments for processing condominium plats. The public hearing was open at 5:06 p.m. There were no written comments. Chris Renaldo, being neutral, expressed concerns regarding the Table C-1, in the draft ordinance, needing to be updated each time there were changes/updates and whether it needed to be on the table or if that information could be stated within the Condominium Plat code chapter. Renaldo also expressed concern about whether 11-14-2(F)(2) was necessary to be included within the draft ordinance. Wichman stated he would recommend the removal of 11-14-2(F)(2) in its entirety. There was no additional testimony being in favor, neutral or in opposition. The public hearing was closed at 5:14 p.m.

Jacob Parsons, City Building Official, stated that there is some language throughout the City Code regarding service and delivery within zones that may need to be looked into. Parsons also stated that there are certain zoning districts that do not allow single-wide homes and believe that needs to be looked into.
