

St. James Catholic School offers the following scholarship and tuition assistance opportunities to those who qualify.

#### 1. FACTS Grant & Aid

- For St. James Catholic Church Parishioners only.
- All families who apply MUST be enrolled for the 2025-2026 school year.
- DEADLINE TO APPLY: Complete and submit application and all supporting documents by Thursday, April 17, 2025.

#### 2. Lambing, Lindh, & Mayer Memorial Scholarship Fund

- This is a needs-based scholarship
- Students do NOT have to be Catholic to receive the scholarship.
- All current students in PK4 through 5th grade who are currently registered for Kindergarten through 6th grade for the 2025-2026 school year are eligible to apply.
- DEADLINE TO APPLY: All applications must be received in the school office no later than 3:00 p.m. on Friday, March 28, 2025. NO EXCEPTIONS will be made for this requirement, for any reason.

### 3. ACE Mississippi Scholarship

- This is a needs-based scholarship awarded to students in Kindergarten through 6th grade.
- Students do NOT have to be Catholic to receive the scholarship.
- DEADLINE TO APPLY: Through April 15th, at 11:59 p.m.

### Lambing, Lindh, & Mayer Memorial Scholarship Fund

Established in 2018, the Lambing, Lindh, & Mayer Memorial Scholarship Fund awards a scholarship(s) in honor of Nola Lambing, David Lindh, and Philip Mayer for their generosity and support of Catholic Education at St. James Catholic School. The scholarship(s) are awarded each spring for use during the next immediate school year.

All current students in PK4 through Grade 5 and students currently registered for Kindergarten through Grade 6 for the 2025-2026 school year are eligible to apply for the scholarship(s) awarded by The Lambing, Lindh, & Mayer Memorial Scholarship Fund. The scholarship(s) is a **Needs Based Scholarship(s)**, and it will be awarded to a student(s) demonstrating satisfactory academic and behavioral performances. A student **does not** have to be Catholic to receive the scholarship. The **Needs Based** qualifications will be determined by the "Essay" section of the scholarship application below.

The scholarship(s) awarded by the Lambing, Lindh, & Mayer Memorial Scholarship Fund is a **1-Year scholarship(s)**. Recipients of a scholarship are eligible to reapply for a scholarship in subsequent school years. Depending on the funds available each year, the scholarship(s) may be a partial scholarship(s) or a full scholarship(s). All information obtained via this application is confidential and will be secured by St. James Catholic School to assure future confidentiality. Furthermore, the information obtained via this application will only be used to determine the scholarship award recipient(s) from the Lambing, Lindh, & Mayer Memorial Scholarship Fund.

### HOW DO I APPLY?

The application for an ACE scholarship is completed on a website called FACTS at the link and QR code below. The application will be open from Monday, February 3 through Tuesday, April 15 at 11:59 p.m. (in the time zone in which the school you are applying with resides).

FOR FAMILIES NEW TO THE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

- 1. Confirm that you qualify for an ACE scholarship based on the financial guidelines listed in the chart on the front.
- 2. Identify the right ACE partner private school for your child.
- 3. Complete the school's application and enrollment process for your child. If the school you are applying to also uses FACTS for their school application, you will use your same FACTS username to apply to both ACE as well as the school. You must complete an application for ACE Scholarships separate from your school application.
- 4. Answer all application questions and submit. You may upload supporting documents later; however, they must be submitted before 11:59 pm on the April 15 deadline in order for the application to be considered complete and eligible for a scholarship.

FOR FAMILIES ALREADY
RECEIVING THE SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Complete the school's application and enrollment process for your child. If the school you are applying to also uses FACTS for their school application, you will use your same FACTS username to apply to both ACE as well as the school. You must use the same FACTS username as the previous school year and complete an application for ACE Scholarships separate from your school application. If the school you are applying to does not use FACTS for their school application, you must still use the same FACTS username as the previous school year.
- 2. Answer all application questions and submit prior to the deadline at 11:59 p.m. on April 15.

\*It is imperative that the application is submitted and complete in order for your child to remain on scholarship.

### DOES MY CHILD QUALIFY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

ACE scholarships are based solely on the family's total income, both taxable (which is line 9 on the 1040 for those who file) and nontaxable and cannot exceed the income guidelines below. See the chart for ACE Scholarships' financial eligibility.

### HOW MUCH ARE THE SCHOLARSHIPS?

ACE Scholarships are partial tuition, intended to provide added assistance lower-income families may need to enroll their child in a private school. Standard ACE award amounts are \$3,000 for K-8 and \$4,000 for high school, not to exceed 50% of private school tuition, yet may vary dependent upon unique circumstances. Families are responsible for working out a payment plan with the school for the remainder of the tuition.
