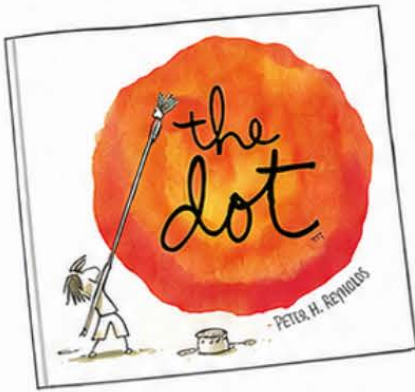


We're celebrating **INTERNATIONAL DOT DAY!**
