





### No belts & untucked shirts

Shirts should be tucked in throughout the day.

Grades 2-6 will wear a black or navy belt with their shorts/slacks.

If a student wears jewelry, only religious necklaces are allowed, under the school uniform shirt.

Girls may wear stud earrings ONLY.

**ALERT**

Uniform violations will be sent home.

After two violations,  
detentions will be given.

### Jackets



Students may wear a navy cardigan, navy sweatshirt or navy fleece inside the school buildings, as long as it is adorned with the St. James crest. Cold weather jackets/coats for outside must be solid navy (no logos, other than school crest). If the temperature is below 32 degrees, students may wear a heavy non-uniform jacket outside only. Please write names in all outerwear.

You may shop

in our uniform closet if you need new uniform pieces. It is a great place to start, and everything is free.



# Did you know? ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but it adds up!

## When a student misses 2 days a month:

- They will miss 20 days a year
- They will miss 30 hours of math over the school year
- They will miss 60 hours of reading and writing over the school year
- They will miss over a year of school by graduation

## When a student misses 4 days a month:

- They will miss 40 days a year
- They will miss 60 hours of math over the school year
- They will miss 120 hours of reading and writing over the school year
- They will miss over 2 years of school by graduation
