- 2. Complete the attached form.
- 3. Submit the attached book review form to your reading teacher on Monday, August 4th.
- 4. Take an AR test on your book by Monday, August 4th.

Rising 5th Grade Students-

- 1. Read two chapter books on the 4th or 5th grade level.
- 2. Complete the attached forms (one for each book).
- 3. Submit the attached book review forms to your reading teacher on Monday, August 4th.
- 4. Take AR tests on your books by Monday, August 4th.

Rising 6th Grade Students-

- 1. Read two chapter books on the 5th or 6th grade level.
- 2. Complete the attached forms (one for each book).
- 3. Submit the attached book review forms to your reading teacher on Monday, August 4th.
- 4. Take AR tests on your books by Monday, August 4th
