4. Try **costplusdrugs.com** for transparent mail-order pricing.

Amazon RxPass — \$5/Month Flat

If you take **2+ chronic medications**, Amazon RxPass is likely the cheapest option at **\$5/month total** (not per drug). Covers 100+ generics for blood pressure, cholesterol, diabetes, thyroid, antidepressants, and more. Requires Amazon Prime. **Not available in CA or WA.**

Decision Tree: Where Should I Fill My Prescription?

If you take 2+ chronic meds...	Start with Amazon RxPass (\$5/mo total). Check if all your meds are eligible at pharmacy.amazon.com/rxpass
If you take 1 chronic med...	Check Walmart \$4/\$9 list first, then GoodRx to compare prices at nearby pharmacies
If you need an antibiotic...	Check GoodRx (antibiotics not on Walmart \$4 list). Costco and Cost Plus are often cheapest.
If you take a brand-name drug...	Ask us about generic alternatives . If none, check costplusdrugs.com and manufacturer copay cards.
If you want maximum savings...	Use GoodRx to compare, then fill at Costco or Walmart . Always ask: "Is a GoodRx coupon cheaper than my copay?"
