- A. SOUTHAMPTON HISTORICAL MUSEUM - (Meeting Lane House) Many historical displays and information available
 - B. SOUTHAMPTON VILLAGE HALL - circa 1912
 - C. OLD STONE FOUNDATION - Old stone foundation was part of the 3rd church 1707, Presbyterian. Later the Methodist Church
 - D. PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH - circa 1843, corner South Main St. & Meeting House Lane
 - E. ROGERS MEMORIAL LIBRARY (Now located on Coopers Farm Road)
 - F. OLD ACADEMY BUILDING (Jobs Lane)
 - G. MONUMENT SQUARE - circa 1902, Memorial to all soldiers and sailors
 - H. WORLD WAR I & WORLD WAR II MEMORIALS - Agawam Park (by the lake)
 - J. SOUTHAMPTON CENTER (Jobs Lane)
 - K. COOPER HALL - circa 1830-40
 - L. LOLA PRENTICE DOG PARK & RECREATED BRITISH FORT
 - M. EARLY CEMETERY with a number of Revolutionary War soldiers' graves
 - N. HERRICK HOUSE - Headquarters for the British General Erskine during English occupation
 - O. CAPTAIN WHITE HOUSE-circa 1815
 - P. 1708 HOUSE - Original part dates back to early 17th century
 - Q. OLD POST HOUSE - Original part date back to early 17th century
 - R. SOUTHAMPTON VILLAGE HALL - circa 1925 (Main Street)
 - S. PELLETREAU SHOP - Silversmith Shop of the Revolutionary War, Patriot Elias Pelletreau


