

F. OLD ACADEMY BUILDING (Jobs Lane)

G. MONUMENT SQUARE - circa 1902, Memorial to all soldiers and sailors

H. WORLD WAR I & WORLD WAR II MEMORIALS - Agawam Park (by the lake)

J. SOUTHAMPTON CENTER (Jobs Lane)

K. COOPER HALL - circa 1830-40

L. LOLA PRENTICE DOG PARK & RECREATED BRITISH FORT

M. EARLY CEMETERY with a number of Revolutionary War soldiers' graves

N. HERRICK HOUSE - Headquarters for the British General Erskine during English occupation

O. CAPTAIN WHITE HOUSE-circa 1815

P. 1708 HOUSE - Original part dates back to early 17th century

Q. OLD POST HOUSE - Original part date back to early 17th century

R. SOUTHAMPTON VILLAGE HALL - circa 1925 (Main Street)

S. PELLETREAU SHOP - Silversmith Shop of the Revolutionary War, Patriot Ellias Pelletreau
