- Parade will roll, rain or shine!

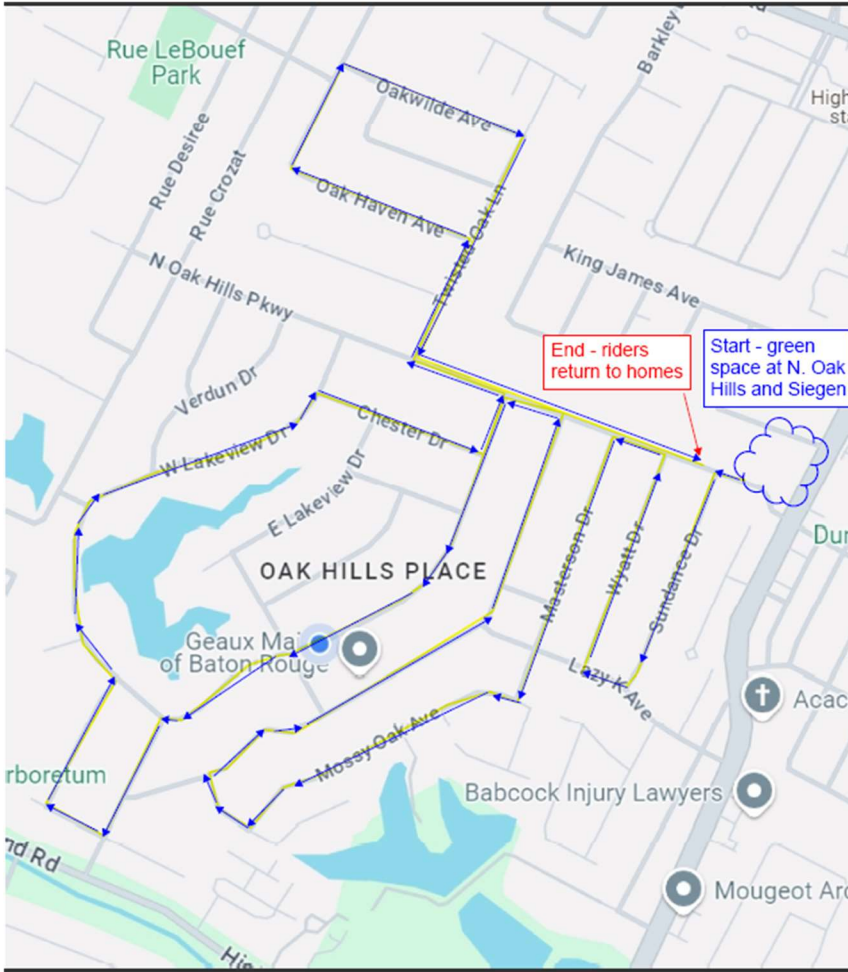
Permissible Vehicles/Rides

- Side-by-Sides
 - o *Trailers pulled by any vehicle listed above are allowed

Prohibited Items/Activities

- **No beads are to be thrown (streets drain into lakes within neighborhood)**
- **No glassware is permitted**
- **No lewd language, clothing, and/or music is permitted**





Admission Requirements

- Must be a current resident in Oak Hills Place, Oak Hills Park, or Oak Hills 3
- Must be at least 18 years old to drive a vehicle
