- The ride will roll, rain or shine!

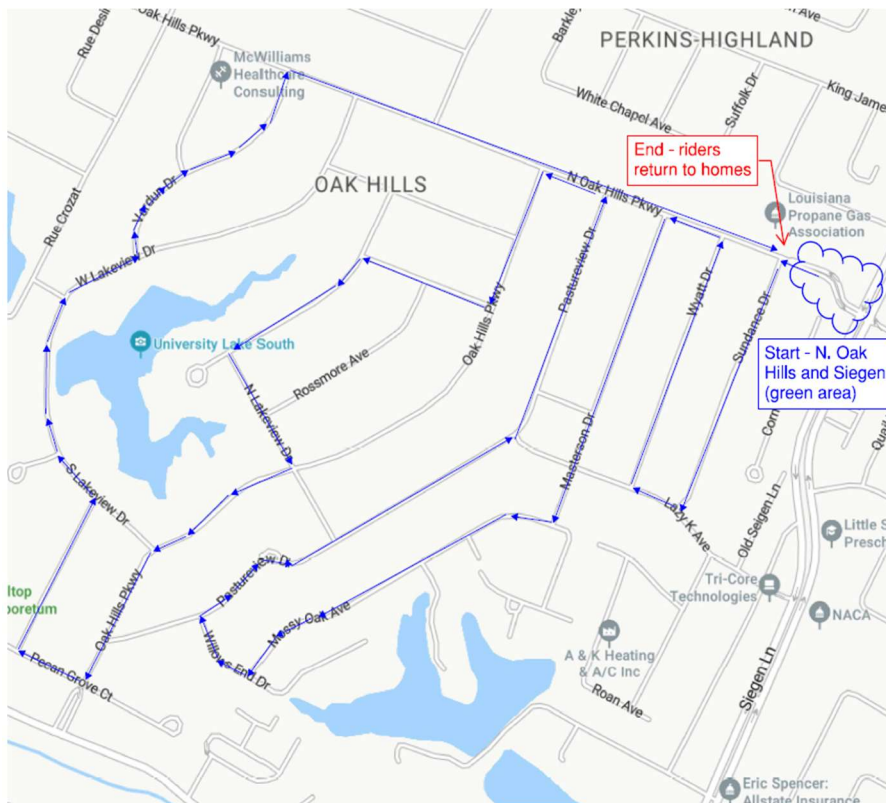
Permissible Vehicles/Rides

 - o *Trailers pulled by any vehicle listed above are allowed

Prohibited Items/Activities

- No speeding or dangerous driving
- No beads are to be thrown (streets drain into lakes within neighborhood)
- No glassware is permitted
- No lewd language, clothing, and/or music is permitted
