

# COVID 19 Response Protocol

The Mamquam River Campground is committed to providing a safe, clean and memorable camping experience for our Guests and a safe campground environment for our Staff and the surrounding community of Squamish. This Covid 19 Response Protocol outlines the onsite expectations and guidelines for our potential Guests, our onsite Guests, Contractors and the General Public for the entire time they are at our campground.

**The protocols listed here in no way replace any Provincial Health Orders (PHO), Regional Restrictions, Municipal Guidelines or Federal Guidelines regarding Covid 19. Please ensure you strictly adhere to the most current governmental and health authority guidelines for the duration of your visit to our campground. This includes the PPE requirements.**

Covid 19 infection risk reduction involves and relies on the support of our guests. Camping should be a worry free, relaxing activity. Please conduct yourself in a socially responsible manner.

**You must adhere to the following guidelines at all times while at our campground.**

- Mamquam River Campground is not open for those who have tested positive or have Covid symptoms and or are seeking a location to Quarantine.
- Please come prepared to camp. Please do not shop for supplies in Squamish if at all possible.
- **Campground staff to assist in all site selection** to ensure physical distancing requirements
- We are restricting occupancy of our single Drive-in sites and Basic Walk-In Tent sites to two adults. 3 Children from the same family are allowed to occupy their Parent or Guardians site. Please contact us by telephone for different ways to accommodate your group.
- **Do not visit unrelated campsites and do not establish gatherings in common areas.**
- Maintain the 2 metre (6 feet) physical distance rules or wear a mask if this is not possible
- Please use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment and sanitizers.
- We supply toilet paper and sanitizer but we suggest that guests bring their own toilet paper and sanitizer. Please sanitize before and after use all High Touch areas you come in contact with.
- **No visitors are permitted, local or otherwise.**
- **No passage thru the campground is permitted**
- Maintain 2 metre (6 feet) distance for all trail usage including trails surrounding Campground
- Pets and children must be closely monitored and supervised.
- Please try to have all payments done online when possible. We accept cash if required.
- Do not give unused firewood to others.

## **Important note:**

During this unprecedented pandemic there is a very strong anti-visitor sentiment in Squamish. We advise that you do not interact with locals if at all possible including avoiding local grocery stores when possible. Our usually very welcoming town is very fearful about the Covid-19 ramifications of your visit to Squamish. Please keep this in mind when accessing local services and your recreation activities. It is very important to limit your recreational activities to minimize the chance of injury to yourself or others.
