If you drive for “[*add School District Name*](#)” School District ONLY, do not complete the top box labeled MEDICAL EXAMINER’S CERTIFICATE; see next step.

Next, you will check a box on the form.

- If you drive for “[*add School District Name*](#)” School District ONLY put an X in the box, **Excepted intrastate – [EI]**. This category allows you to drive in any of the United States.
- If you drive a CDL vehicle for someone else AND must carry a medical examiner’s DOT medical card put an X in the box, **Non-excepted interstate – [NI]**. Your current DOT Medical Card must be given to the driver license facility employee (copy or original). Complete the top of the form labeled MEDICAL EXAMINER’S CERTIFICATE. This category allows you to drive in any of the United States.

The last step in completing the form is signing and dating the disclosure statement.

Information regarding categories...

- **After you renew your driver’s license your category will be immediately available to law enforcement officials throughout the United States.**
- **If your category changes you are responsible to notify the Secretary of State (SOS).**
- **Excepted = exempt.**
- **Intrastate = every state outside of Illinois in the United States.**
- **EI = exempt from carrying a medical card and can drive in any state in the United States.**
- **NI = must hold a current medical card that has been registered in the Illinois SOS database and can drive in any state in the United States. You no longer need to carry the DOT Medical card.**
