*We have been fortunate to have Brentley come to live with his sister, grandmother and a multitude of aunts, uncles, and cousins here at Cedarwood. Brentley is a typey chocolate male exhibiting potential in obedience, show, and field.*

**2001 Breed Ranking:** Brentley limited his appearance in 2001 to the LRCGB and the National Specialty. With that limited showing he completed 2001 ranked the number 24 Labrador in the US.

**2001 NATIONAL SPECIALTY SHOW:** Brentley and three other Champion Master Hunters welcomed this year's National Specialty Show participants as the Show's Color Guard, sporting red, white and blue bandannas and sitting at attention as the National Anthem was sung. Brentley continued to be in the colors throughout the show...qualifying in Veteran Obedience, winning his class in Veteran Sweepstakes and then going on to receive Best in Veteran Sweepstakes. Brentley teamed up with his niece, Can. CH. Cedarwood's Laurel - together earning third in the Brace Class. As Friday afternoon wore on, Brentley and I found ourselves making the cut under Best of Breed Judge, Douglas Winsor. The invitation to lead the two bitches previously moved to the center around the ring for one last look was the highlight of the afternoon and resulted in Brentley receiving the coveted *purple and gold. Best In the 2001 National Specialty Show!!!* Certainly, the frosting on a fabulous career for Brentley and a once in a lifetime opportunity for me...we continue in Utility!

**ALRC SPECIALTY SHOW:** Brentley made the trip to Halifax, NS in September where he completed his Canadian CD with multiple placements including a High in Class earning him an invitation to the Atlantic Obedience Awards in Charlotte Town, PEI in late October. Brentley also made an appearance at ALRC Specialty Show and was selected as Best Veteran, Best in Veteran Sweepstakes, Best Gun Dog and Judges Award for Merit under Breeder/Judge Lisa Weiss, LoBuff.

**SHOW:** Brentley began his show career this past year (1998) between Hunt Test seasons. Nicely presented by Norman Grenier and Constance Holt-Grenier he has earned four majors in the US and acquired the number of points necessary to complete his breed championship. His first win under Judge Dean was a respectable four point major which was earned going Best of Breed from the open chocolate class over 9 Specials and an entry of 64. His second major was awarded at the Iriquois Labrador Club's Supported Entry under Breeder Judge Czerwinski "Broadway". Brentley returned to Maine to continue his Hunt Test Career early in the Spring and completed his Master Hunter this June (1998). Brentley reentered the show scene going WD on 8/29 and RWD on 8/30 in Waldoboro and WD BOW on 9/27 in Lewiston and picking up a third major under Judge Nickles on 10/10! He was also third open chocolate at the 1998 LRC, Inc. National Specialty in Gray Summit, MO the following week. Taking a break to enjoy the fall and winter waterfowl season, he returned to the breed ring in March picking up a nice win under Breeder-Judge Sally Bell "Borador" for his fourth major and breed championship. Brentley made the cut as a Special at the 1999 LRC, Inc. National Specialty and received a Judge's Award for Merit at the 2000 LRC, Inc. National Specialty in Seattle under Breeder-Judge Marion Lyons.

He has a pleasing head, great coat, otter tail and fabulous temperament to compliment the trainability and breed type. He has already produced some lovely black and chocolate puppies. Brentley congratulates his kids who have received breed championships, specialty recognition, advanced hunting and obedience titles.

**OBEDIENCE:** Brentley has completed his Companion Dog title in his early career and has earned his CDX this fall (1999). He is presently perfecting his utility exercises. This year [2002] Brentley competed with three other veterans in the Team Obedience Competition - Ironside and the Steel Magnolias. They placed third entertaining themselves, the judges and the audience.

**FIELD:** Brentley completed his Senior Hunter in four consecutive tests handled by Bill Clark. He has gone on to earn the five qualifying scores for his Master Title. He enjoys sea duck and waterfowl hunting and is excellent on upland game. Like his dam, his marking ability, memory and desire to retrieve has set him above the pack. Carl is delighted to have him home and he will be seen on a limited basis at Breed Specialties, but always on the sea ledges and inland bogs of Maine.

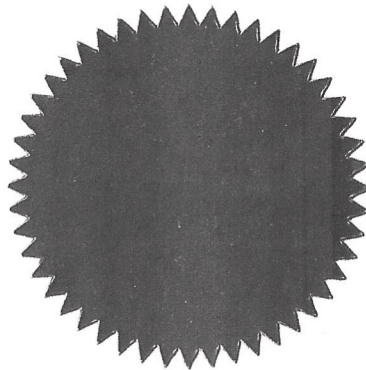

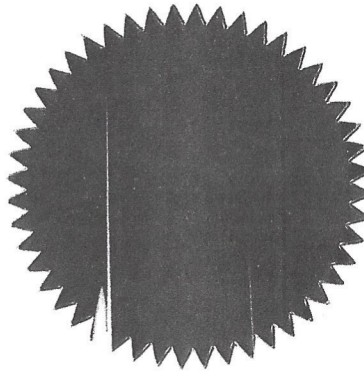
