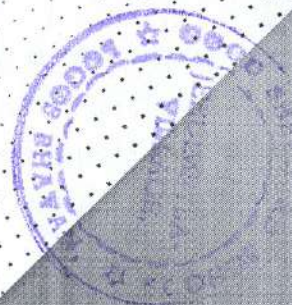

School Profile

Good Shepherd School was established in the year 2001 in Hyderabad at Logos Bhavan, Jeedimetla, Suchitra Junction, Telangana (then Andhra Pradesh).

Academics

The school began its new year on a high note of celebration, powered by the exceptional performance of its Class X students. Again achieving a flawless **100% success rate** in the CBSE Board Exams, the batch has made their mark through sheer diligence and academic rigor. This extraordinary outcome is the direct result of the harmonious hard work shared between the students and their teachers—a partnership that transformed potential into performance and challenges into triumphs.

Parent Orientation Program

In keeping with our longstanding annual tradition, the session was inaugurated with the Parent Orientation Programme for Classes IX–X. This dedicated forum was designed to provide parents with a comprehensive overview of our school's pedagogical framework, curricular expectations, and operational practices. Furthermore, we prioritized an open dialogue, setting aside ample time for an interactive Q&A session to proactively address and resolve any queries or concerns that parents might have regarding their child's academic journey.

Assessment schedule

To promote steady academic growth, conceptual understanding, and improved outcomes, our school implements a systematic assessment plan across the academic year. The evaluation framework comprises Mock Tests (for Grades IX–X), four Unit Tests (for Grades III–X), three Pre-Board Examinations (for Grades IX–X), and two Term Examinations (for Grades I–X).

School Houses

The school's students are organized into four distinct houses—Amber, Emerald, Ruby, and Sapphire. Each house is overseen by a House Mistress, supported by Associate House Masters, House Captains, and House Prefects. The house assigned duty is responsible for conducting the morning assembly and various competitions in a systematic and disciplined manner.

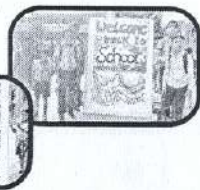

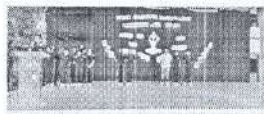


CELEBRATING AMBEDKAR JAYANTHI

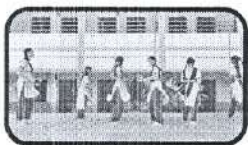
HARITHA HARAM

NATIONAL LITERACY DAY

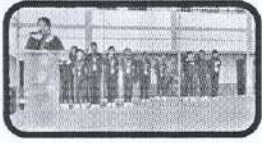
Our school observed National Literacy Day on 8th September with the theme "Essential vs. Non-Essential" —helping students distinguish between what truly matters in life and what does not.

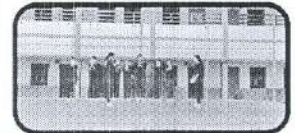
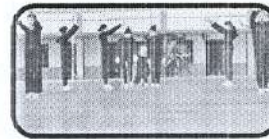


"LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE: PREAMBLE DAY PLEDGE"

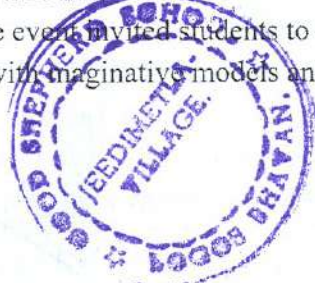
INDEPENDENCE DAY

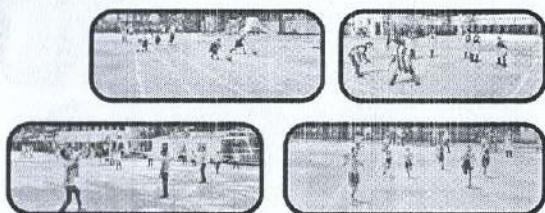

Held on August 26, 2025, the event invited students to explore God's magnificent creation with imaginative models and engaging space-themed exhibits.



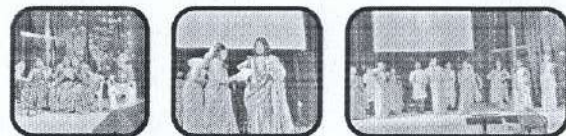


MAJOR DHYAN CHAND SPORTS DAY - STRIVE, RUN, ACHIEVE

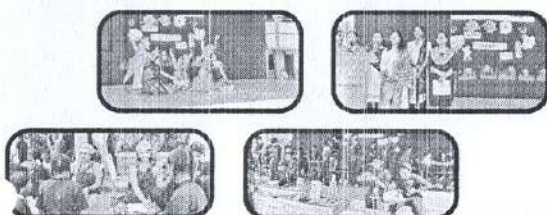
TEACHER'S DAY

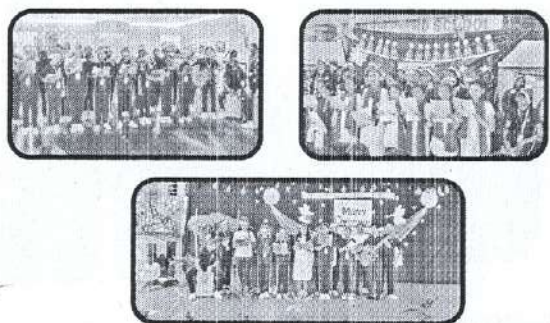
AIDS DAY OBSERVANCE

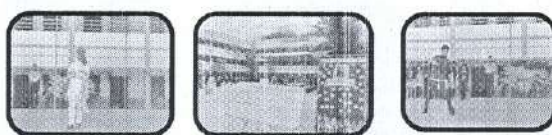
JOYFUL CHRISTMAS CELEBRATIONS AT GSS-JDM

On January 12, 2026, GSS-JDM marked National Youth Day with a special assembly inspiring students through the ideals of Swami Vivekananda.



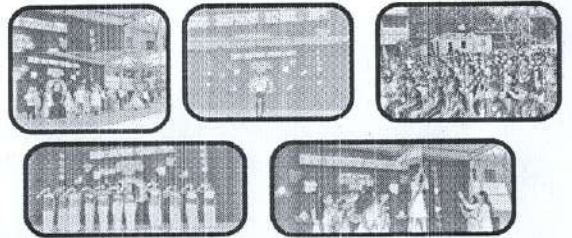
FAREWELL: A JOURNEY OF FAITH, FRIENDSHIP AND FOND MEMORIES

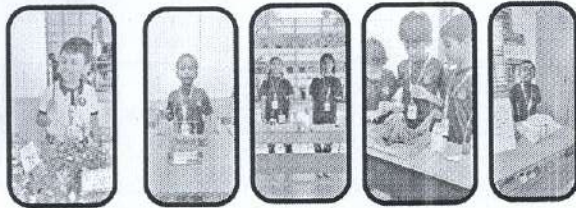
UNITY IN DIVERSITY - REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

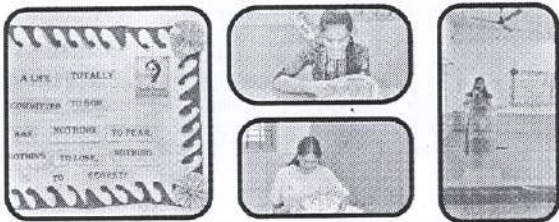

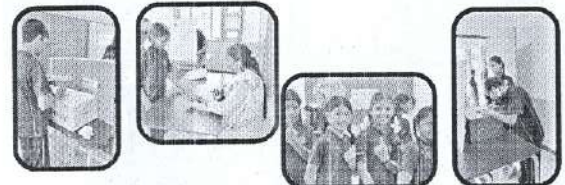
A DAY OF REMEMBRANCE AND INSPIRATION: PANDIT RAMABAI

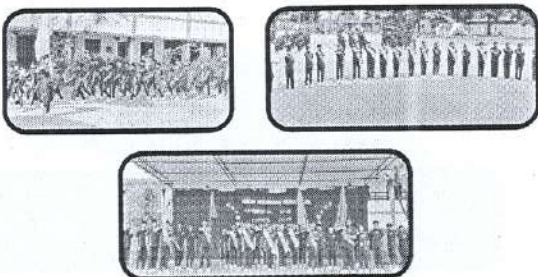
ELECTION

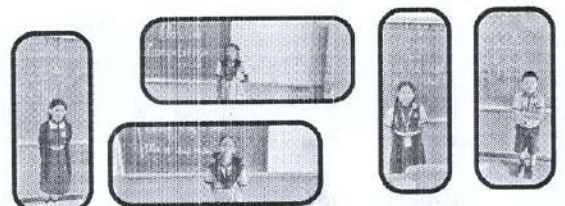
INVESTITURE CEREMONY

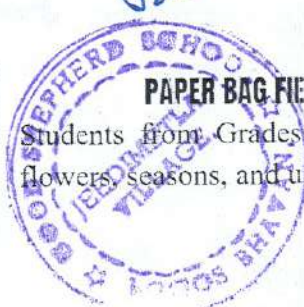
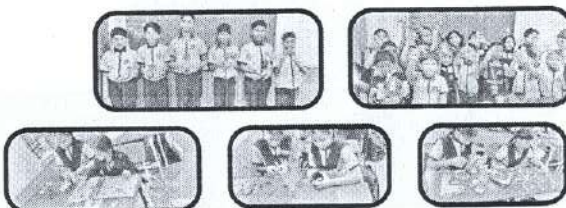

On 27 June our students energetically participated in elocution activity where different topics were given to them like My role model, A world without plastic, Good manners, Discipline a key to success and Effect of social media



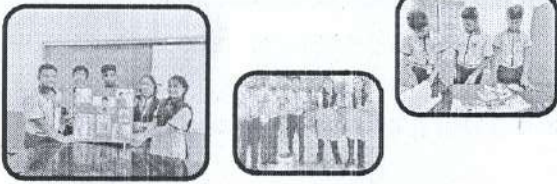
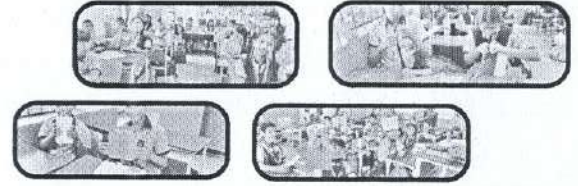
PAPER BAG FIESTA - "CRAFTING NATURE WITH COLOUR!"

On October 16, 2025, Grades 3–8 created eco-friendly paper bags through Eco Club, promoting environmental responsibility and reducing plastic use.

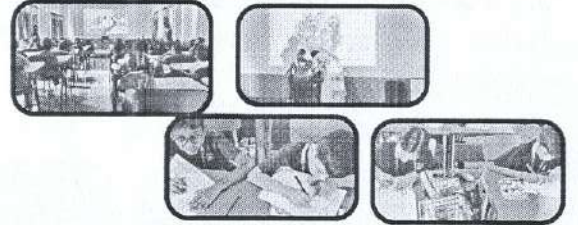


“VIKSIT BHARAT BUILDATHON 2025: YOUNG MINDS, BIG IDEAS!”

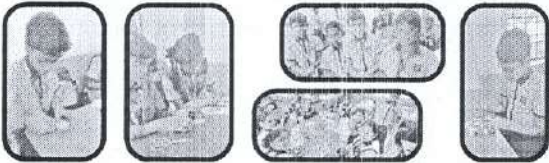
DREAM BIG, SHINE BRIGHT

On October 25-27, Students of Classes VI–X participated in Cyber Security Week, learning safe online practices and the importance of responsible digital behaviour.



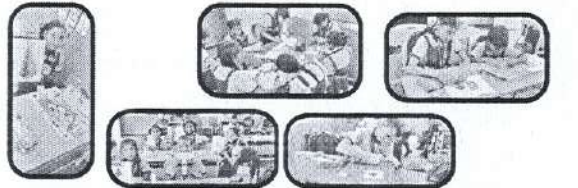
VALUES THAT SHINE -VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK

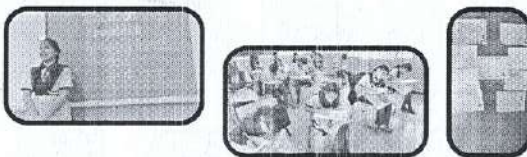
“CELEBRATING EMMANUEL - GOD WITH US IN EVERY CREATION!”

On January 12, 2026, GSS celebrated Makar Sankranti with vibrant Rangoli and kite-making competitions, with Ruby House emerging as the winner.

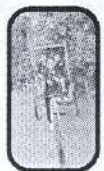
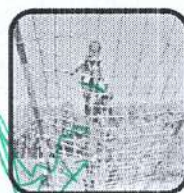
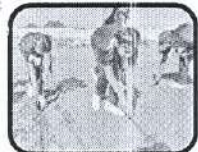
FOOTBALL TRAINING WORKSHOP 2026

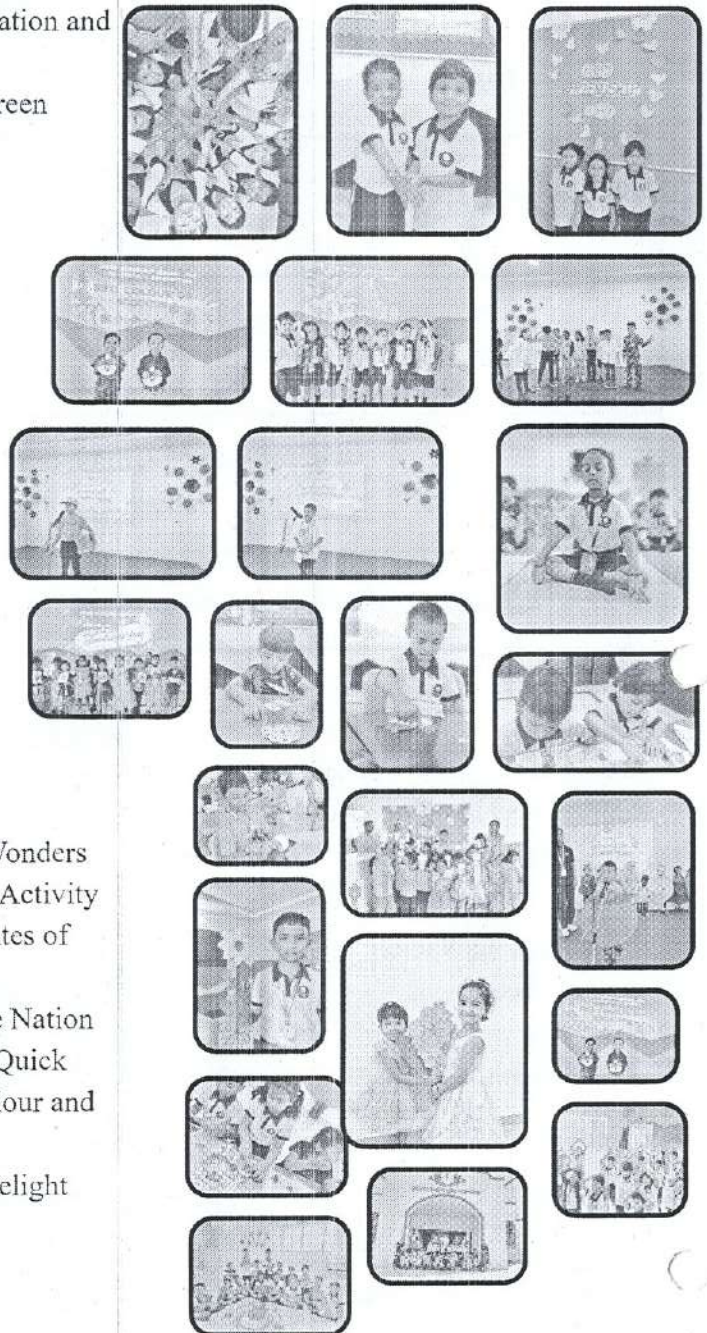
