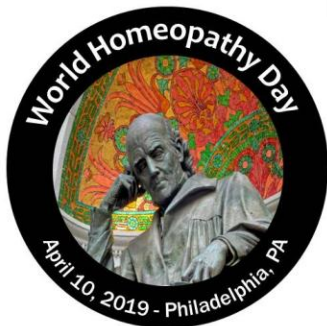

Philadelphia, PA – Annual World Homeopathy Day, to be celebrated this year in Philadelphia, in honor of the founder of homeopathic medicine, Samuel Hahnemann is a momentous event, since it is also to commemorate the role of the Philadelphian homeopaths in the development of homeopathy around the world and whose teachings are still highly regarded.

The World Conference covers the Historical & Scientific Validation of Homeopathy. This is an all day event beginning at 9AM with lecturers covering topics such as the history of homeopathy and its legislative battles as well as the future of research in homeopathy. Guest lecturers include Dr. Ron Whitmont, Dr. John S. Haller, Jr., Dr. Renzo Galassi, Dr. Alex Bekker and Dr. Jennifer Jacobs. The critically acclaimed film "Just One Drop" featuring Q&A with Director and Producer Laurel Chiten will be screened at the conclusion.

Stay after the film for a Concert with Paul Winter & Friends featuring Theresa Thomason beginning at 8:30 PM. Paul Winter has performed around the world, from New York's Carnegie Hall to the Miho Museum in Japan. One of the earliest exponent's of world music, the group has also pioneered a new genre of "earth music," (described as "ecological jazz" by fans in Russia), interweaving classical, jazz and world music elements with voices from what Winter calls "the greatest symphony of the earth." Theresa Thomason is an extraordinary Gospel Singer and featured artist with the Paul Winter Consort at the annual Solstice, Missa Gaia and Earth Mass celebrations. (paulwinter.com)
