BOTOX

What is Botox? Botulinum toxin injections, such as Botox, relax the muscles in your face to smooth out lines and wrinkles.

Where can you treat with Botox? Infusion offers Botox to the upper part of the face. Frown line, forehead and around the eyes.

Does Botox hurt? This procedure causes minimal discomfort during administration, which does not persist once the treatment is complete.

How quickly will I see the results? All patients differ, however usually within 5-7 days you will see the effects beginning to take. It can take up to 2 weeks for the optimum results.

How long does it last? Typically, around 3 months from date of initial injections. Maintenance is advised every 3-4 months.

When is it best to start having Botox? So many patients will ask if they are too old or too young to have Botox. To help make your decision based on your own personal needs, a medical consultation should be carried out prior to your treatment. This also includes a medical questionnaire to ensure suitability for Botox.

Are there any side effects? The most common side effects that can occur, include redness to the injection point, small bruises and occasionally a headache post treatment. However, these will all resolve within a matter of hours or a day or two.

Is there any specific after care? Very simple after-care instructions and advice will be provided during your appointment following your treatment.

HYPERHIDROSIS	What is Hyperhidrosis? Hyperhidrosis is a condition that causes excess sweating. Infusion can treat this condition when it affects under the armpits. The condition occurs when the sweat glands over produce. By blocking the nerve signals, will stop the sweat glands from producing too much sweat.
	How does Botox help hyperhidrosis? Botulinum toxin is injected under the armpit to control the symptoms of severe sweating. It temporarily blocks the chemical signals from the nerve that stimulates the sweat glands.
	How long do the results last? At least 6 months.
	Are there side effects to the treatment? Most common side effects can include a very small amount of tenderness to the treated site and possibly some redness, a small amount of swelling and bruising. All of which resolve quickly.
DERMAL FILLERS:	What are dermal fillers? Injectables that fill the fine lines and facial wrinkles, restoring a smoother appearance. Most dermal fillers consist of hyaluronic acid. The fillers are temporary and are absorbed by the body.
	Where can I have dermal fillers? Infusion offers fillers to the lip border, nasolabial folds, marionette lines and smoker's lines.
	Do they hurt? A small amount of topical numbing cream can be applied to ensure minimal discomfort during the treatment.
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	Are there side effects? A small amount of redness and bruising can occur post treatment. But this will resolve in a few days.
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PROFHILO & SKINWhat is it and how does it work? A treatment that improves skinBOOSTERS:tone, texture, hydration, and overall radiance of the skin. The
injections of hyaluronic acid help to increase firmness and
elasticity and promotes healthier looking skin. Can be used on the
face and neck area and the hands also.

How long do the results last? 2 treatments are recommended, 4 weeks apart for optimum results. This treatment lasts up to and around 6 months.

Does it hurt? A small amount of topical numbing cream can be applied to ensure minimal discomfort during the treatment.

Are there any side effects? There is occasionally some redness and itching and raised bumps under the skin at injection point. This is all completely normal and should resolve quickly.

What after care should I follow? All after care advice will be provided at your appointment following your treatment.
