KENTUCKY RAILWAY MUSEUM CAR SHOW



KYANA SECOND ANNUAL CAR SHOW

Recap of the Second Annual KYANA Charities Car Show by Jerry Bass

On Labor Day KYANA hosted the Second Annual KYANA Charities Car Show on the clubhouse grounds. It was a great success. The weather couldn't have been better with sunny skies and a high of only 82 degrees. We had a total of 128 cars in the show of which 71 were non-members. This is more than double the participation over last year. We promoted the show more heavily this year with Facebook and flyers and had participants come from as far as Eastern KY, middle Tennessee, and as close as Lexington. The quality of the cars was greatly improved as well.

We tried a new approach to generate donations from the participants this year. Rather than have a 50/50 raffle, which required KYANA Charities to apply for a gaming license and open our books to the City of Louisville, it was suggested by a member to have a "Silent Auction". As the name suggests, bidders record their amounts on paper for the item(s) they want and the highest bidder wins. Eight auction items were compiled by Mark and Pat Kubancik, Randy and Emily Puckett, and Carol and myself. The auction items ranged from things for ladies to tools for men. It was very well received and we will do it again next year.

The show would not have been successful without the careful dedication of a handful of volunteers who staffed the registration, t-shirt sales, silent auction, announcements, parking, judging, and concession areas. A big thanks to all who volunteered and made the show possible.


