I'll say to myself, I can put this little project off until this winter when I have time. Next thing I know; I've completely forgotten about it.

On the way to the Kyana Awards and Elections Dinner in our '66 Chevy Bel Air Marcia said, "What's that smell?" I said, "Smells like antifreeze." She said, "What is all this liquid in the floorboard?"
