

Since August 2017, the Haddon Township Education Foundation (HTEF) has made significant progress – from formulation to implementation – to support learning in Haddon Township Schools through the provision of grants to district faculty and staff.

The HTEF has raised over \$250,000 through a combination of donations and events to support its grantmaking. Over 250 volunteers have supported 25 fundraising events including raffles, golf outings and events on Haddon Square.

Our grants are at the classroom-level, school-specific, and district-wide. They support student success across a number of areas including math, science, multi-sensory learning, arts, library, language arts, fitness, and wellness.

In 2023 the HTEF Board of Trustees created an endowment fund. The goal of the endowment is to raise at least \$1,000,000. This will provide \$40,000 per year to the HTEF operating budget.

We continue to work to provide future grants, but we do not exist without the support of our community. The continued submission of grant applications from district personnel as well as donations and volunteer time from residents and friends allow the HTEF to continue to grow its impact on students.

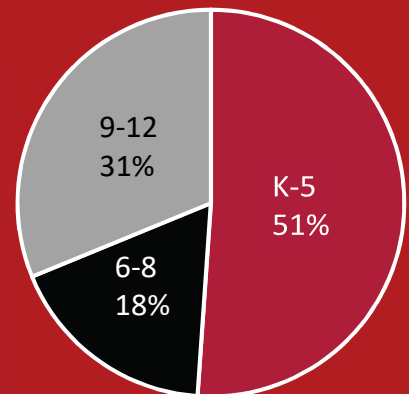
Students impacted by HTEF grants
